# 2018 'BIG DEALER' REPORT

#### An Ag Equipment Intelligence Staff Report

The "Big Dealer" report is a joint project of *Ag Equipment Intelligence* and George Russell of the Machinery Advisors Consortium. This report aims to track ownership changes and consolidation trends of North American farm equipment dealers. For the purposes of this report, "Big Dealers" are considered those retail organizations that own and operate 5 or more farm equipment store locations within the U.S. and Canada. This compilation was initiated in 2009, was first published in 2011 and is updated annually in April.

#### 'Biggest' Ag Equipment Dealers Continue to Expand Their Reach

If there is one factor that is driving the biggest farm equipment dealerships in the U.S. and Canada to continue adding locations, it is the need to scale their businesses to keep up with the demands being placed on them. It's an ongoing trend that isn't slowing down or going away.

Investopedia defines scalability as a "characteristic of a system, model or function that describes its capability to cope and perform under an increased or expanding workload. A system that scales well will be able to maintain or even increase its level of performance or efficiency when tested by larger operational demands."

Some say dealers need scale to not only keep up with their customers' demands — farmers who are also expanding — but to be profitable.

In compiling the 2018 Big Dealer report, it was interesting to note that there are actually fewer "big" North American farm equipment dealer-principals or ownership groups at this point in 2018 than there were

a year ago. For the purposes of this report, "Big Dealers" are defined as those dealership groups that own and operate 5 or more farm equipment retail locations.

Currently, the count is 188 big dealers vs. 191 a year ago. Despite fewer dealership groups overall, dealer consolidation is not slowing down. In fact, a quick review of the numbers shows that growth of the "biggest" big dealers continues to escalate, while the number of the "smallest" big dealers is where the shrinkage is taking place.

Since 2009, Ag Equipment Intelligence, in partnership with the Machinery Advisors Consortium (MAC), has compiled a ranking of farm equipment retailers based on the number of ag stores. The first "Big Dealer" report was published in 2011 and has been updated annually ever since. During the period of 2011-18, "big" farm equipment dealerships have grown by more than 11%. But this doesn't totally reflect what's real-

ly happening within the farm machinery retail distribution channel.

#### 'Biggest' Dealers Continue Expanding

Overall, the percentage of dealers in each of the 4 different size categories — 20-plus stores, 15-19 stores, 10-14 stores and 5-9 stores — held steady during the first 7 years of the study, but significant shifting has taken place particularly in the past year.


Generally, the dealer groups with 20 or more stores represented 5-6% of the total between 2011-17 but increased to 8% in 2018. Dealers in the next category, 15-19 stores, is where much of the shifting has taken place. In 2011, this group represented only 3% of the total. This grew to 9% in 2017 and then jumped to 15% in 2018.

The next tier, dealers with 10-14 store locations, grew steadily over the past 7 years. Starting at 17% of the total in 2011, by 2017 it had increased to 21% and stands at about 23% in 2018. While dealers in the smallest group, 5-9 locations, held at about 75% of the total through 2013, the following year its percentage dropped to about 66%, where it stayed until the current year. In 2018, the smallest "big" dealers' percentage of the total fell to about 55% of all big dealers. Clearly, it has been dealers in the 15-19 store locations' group that has shown the most continuous growth during the past 7 years.

The top tier of big dealers, those with 20 or more store locations, has grown from 8 in 2011 to 15 in 2018, a growth rate of about 88%. On the other hand, the lowest tier of the big dealers (5-9 operating locations) have declined by nearly 20%. In 2011, this tier of dealers had 128 groups, but their numbers have fallen to 103 in 2018.

The real story, though, is in the second tier of big dealer groups. Dealerships that own and operate 15-19 store locations have grown by more than 400% between 2011-18. Taken together, dealership groups with 10 or more stores have grown from 25% of the total big dealer group in 2011 to 45% in the past year.

#### Biggest Changes in the Past Year

Since the 2017 edition of the Big Dealer report was published in May of last year, several noticeable shifts have taken place, including how the dealer rankings are tallied. In the past, all of a dealer's farm equipment locations were included, whether they were in the U.S. and Canada or overseas. In the 2018 edition, only North American dealership locations are included when it comes to calculting the rankings. Dealers with stores outside of North America are noted in their individual listings in the table that starts on page 6.

This change only affected two dealership groups. Titan Machinery has 20 dealerships in Bulgaria, Romania, Serbia and Ukraine. Cervus Equipment has 14 dealerships in Australia and New Zealand.

As a result of this change, Titan Machinery slipped one spot to No. 2 on the list from its No. 1 rank last year. (It should also be noted, Titan did some "right sizing" in the past couple of years, which also reduced their overall ag store count.) Cervus Equipment dropped from No. 3 last year to No. 15 in 2018.

Other significant shifts also changed the rankings this year. The biggest was Ag-Pro taking over the top spot with 57 ag stores. Ag-Pro, a John Deere dealership based in Boston, Ga., started out as Boston Tractor, rebranded itself in 2012 as Ag-Pro. At that point the dealer group operated 11 store locations. This had grown to 24 stores by 2014. That year the company sold 7 Arkansas locations to Greenway. In 2015, Ag-Pro acquired 11 stores from South Texas Implement, giving them 35 locations. In 2017, the dealership group had grown to 36 locations when it added 19 locations. This included 6 separate acquisitions, including 7 from Snead Ag. It also opened 3 new locations that year. By 2018, Ag-Pro had grown to 57 stores across 5 states (GA, SC, AL, FL, TX) when it opened sales and rental locations in Quitman, Ga. Several of Ag-Pro's acquisitions and new store openings fall into the category of "rural lifestyle" equipment businesses.

Another significant addition to the



The number of dealer groups operating 10 or more store locations increased to 83, up from 70 a year earlier. The total number of stores operated by these dealers rose to 2,580 vs. 1,490 last year. Overall, these dealers own 2,052 ag-only locations, an average of 11 stores each.

Farm equipment dealership groups that own 15 or more farm equipment stores took a big jump in 2018 to 41 from 29 in 2017. In total, this group of dealers operated 1,162 total retail locations in 2018, an average of about 28 each. Taking into account only ag equipment locations, the average was 21 stores each. Since 2011, the number of dealerships that operate 15 or more store locations have more than tripled and the number of ag store locations they operate has increased by about 36%.

top 10 list this year is Meade Tractor. The company was a Deere construction equipment dealership with 10 locations in Kentucky and Tennessee. In rapid style, Meade added "farm and home" stores and today operates 23 of these stores across 5 states (TN, KY, VA, WV, NC). In January 2018, Meade Tractor announced it had acquired 9 Limestone Farm Lawn Worksite of Kentucky stores. Meade occupies the No. 11 spot on the 2018 Big Dealer list, up from No. 96 in 2017.

Another big move by a John Deere dealer was the acquisition of Larson Farm and Lawn's 9 stores in Missouri and Arkansas by Heritage Tractor. This gave Heritage 17 total locations in Kansas, Missouri and Arkansas. That placed them at No. 23 in the Big Dealer rankings, up from No. 83 in 2017.

South Dakota-based C&B Operations also made headway in expanding its base, moving up to No. 3 in the Big Dealer rankings for 2018 with 38 locations. Last year C&B was No. 9 with 24 locations.

#### Deere Fuels Consolidation Push

It's clear that Deere dealership groups continue to be the most aggressive when it comes to acqui-

sitions. Even before *Ag Equipment Intelligence* and the Machinery Advisers Consortium (MAC) began documenting the consolidation trends in farm equipment distribution channels, John Deere was out front of the rest of the industry.

"Clearly, Deere is the leader in consolidating its dealers and the gap between Deere and the others continue to increase," says George Russell, cofounder of MAC and partner in compiling the annual Big Dealer report. He doesn't expect the pressure on Deere dealers to expand to abate any time in the foreseeable future.

While Deere may not be directly pushing its dealers to consolidate, it continues to raise its expectations for dealer revenues and capabilities that, in many cases, result in dealers seeking buyers or partners for their businesses. Likewise, some of its dealers are aggressively pursuing acquisitions that will give them the type of scale that allows them to grow revenues to meet the company's targets and to be profitable.

In 2011, there were 24 Deere dealers with 10 or more stores. Today, there are 61. By contrast, Case IH had 4 dealers with 10-plus store locations in 2011, AGCO had 13 and New Holland had 2. In 2018, Case IH has 13, AGCO has 11 and New Holland 2.

Considering all levels of big dealers — those with 5 or more store locations — more than one-half of the 188 big dealerships are John Deere dealers. A little over one-half of Case

In many cases, Deere dealers wanting to expand come under pressure to drop lines that Deere considers competitive to its own products. Claas and Krone are two examples of long line manufacturers needing to seek other channels for equipment distribution.

Claas is taking some non-traditional approaches to expanding its dealer network by opening companyowned outlets, as well as falling back on its international presence to bring in foreign owned and operated dealer groups. Krone, too, has also invested in company-owned retail locations. During the past few years, Krone has opened 5 stores: 3 in California, 2 in Wisconsin and one in Idaho.

As it moves into the production agriculture segment, Kubota is also seeking to bolster its dealers ranks. In Canada, the company says it's looking for dealers (whether or not they're current Kubota dealers) to invest in standalone Kubota facilities.

## Private Equity Investors' Growing Interest

Russell also notes that there continues to be interest from private equity investors in acquiring dealerships. But he adds, "If a dealer is looking to sell, they'll need to be big enough to attract a private equity company. Most of the ones I've spoken with are looking for dealers with at least \$100 million in annual revenues. Some may take a look at dealers with lower sales," but this appears to be a starting point for them to even considering buying, he says.

At least 8 dealer groups are now owned by private equity firms. The list includes:

• Atlantic Tractor (9 JD & Kubota

- stores in MD, PA, DE) acquired by McCombie Group
- Moody's Equipment (8 NH stores in SK) acquired by PFM Capital
- Pattison Ag (19 JD stores in SK, MB) which acquired Maple Farm Equipment and JayDee AgTech
- Groupe JLD Lague (16 JD stores in QC, ON) acquired by Champlain Financial Corp.
- Booth Machinery (6 CIH stores in AZ, CA) by EverWatch Financial

- Belkorp Ag (5 JD stores in CA) acquired Joaquin Tractor and Rainbow Ag
- LandPro Equipment (12 JD stores in NY) Lakeland Equipment and Z&M Ag and Turf acquired by Argonne Capital Group
- Agri-Service (14 AGCO stores in ID, UT, OR) acquired by Western States Equipment, which was previously acquired by The Terteling Co.

This table shows the ranking of individual "big dealers" (dealership groups that operate 5 or more retail stores) that are located in each state. It does not reflect the total number of dealerships in each state or province. A review of where the farm equipment's biggest dealers are located is a good indicator or where states and provinces stand when it comes to agricultural production. A possible exception is Texas, which is ranked No. 1. While it is a significant producer of agricultural products, the two largest producers in terms of production value are California and lowa. The number of big dealerships in the state is probably more of a reflection of the geographical size of the state.

take the ESOP (Employee Stock Ownership Plan) route in lieu of selling outright. These include: H&R Agri-Power (15 CIH, NH stores in KY, IL, TN, AL and MS) and Bane-Welker (13 CIH stores in IN, OH).

### Other Drivers & Benefits of Dealership Consolidation

In addition to the competitive pressure between the major OEMs, as well as their dealers, is the OEMs belief that fewer, but bigger dealers are needed because they are better able to invest in training to provide technical support for more demanding customers, according to Russell. But the manufacturers aside, he says, as big of a driving force for the dealers themselves is to develop a financially viable exit strategy.

"Dealers who are Baby Boomers are looking for a way to transfer capital out of their businesses as they look to retire," says Russell. "I expect this will be a major driver of dealer consolidation during the next decade." Besides selling to other dealers, some see private equity investors or ESOPs providing a more equitable and financially sound way of transferring the capital that they have built up in their businesses over the past several decades.

A poll conducted by *Farm Equipment* magazine 3 years ago indeed revealed that more than three-quarters of dealer-principals are 51 years old or older. Of this group, slightly more than 37% are 61 or older. Only about 26% are 50 years old or younger.

Russell says Deere's effort to consolidate its dealers has also caused their competitors to react and he expects to see an escalation of consolidation efforts by Case IH and AGCO, in particular.

At the same time, he says, "there's the perception in some cases that they [bigger Deere dealers] are losing touch with their customers and the other brands are benefiting from this. But what Deere has done is to put in the next level of processes in place. Whether it's locking people in with technology solutions, or insisting their dealers put processes like customer relations management system in place so they don't lose contact with their customers."

As dealers expand their territories they're also looking for the talent needed to support their growing operations, according to Russell.

"I'm seeing more and more dealer groups hiring a marketing person. And they're saying, 'We wish would have done this sooner," he says. "And it's not just social media marketing and having a nice website. They're seeing how a good marketing person can help their used equipment turns and with technical support, in terms of where customers go for support. It's helping them realize the benefits of offering 24/7 support. They're helping dealers build relationships and to take advantage of 'professional marketing' methods," Russell adds.

#### **Store Numbers Grow**

As would be expected, the number of stores big dealers operate has grown at an even higher rate than overall M&A numbers. In 2018, the 188 big dealers operated 2,580 total dealership locations; on average, these dealers had about 14 stores each. Considering only ag retail locations, Big Dealers had 2,052 separate locations, for an average of 11 stores per dealership group.

If only the largest big dealer groups are considered, those with 15 or more locations, the 41 largest dealers owned 1,162 total locations, which averages out to 28 stores per operating group. When considering ag only locations, these dealers had 868, for an average of about 22 stores per group.
